WHICH CONTEXT FOR YOUR INTERNSHIP?

ACT*eon* is looking for an **intern** to contribute to the development and implementation of its research and consultancy projects focusing on the setting up of an **European policy framework** that supports the societal transition Europe requires to deliver a healthy, productive, resilient and sustainable ocean.

- The search for innovative (technical and non-technical) solutions that can improve the health and resilience of marine and coastal ecosystems with particular interest in **nature-based solutions**;
- The identification of **leverages** that can up-scale the application of these solutions;
- Adaptations in the implementation of policies to enhance **policy coherence** and deliver better outcomes in terms of (marine) biodiversity protection and resilience;
- The assessment of environmental, social and economic impacts of the upscaling of solutions and policy changes;
- The development of **capacity-building tutorials and training** for public and private sector professionals involved in the design, implementation and evaluation of EU policies

WHAT WILL YOU DO DURING YOUR INTERNSHIP?

As intern, you will contribute to the life and activities of the above-mentioned projects, working **closely with Acteon staff** and project coordinators as well as **projects' partners** from a wide range of EU countries.

The exact focus of your internship in terms of tasks & assignments will be specified during the application process through iterative exchanges, then consolidated during the preparation phase of your internship. This ensures the internship accounts for the objectives and activities of ongoing projects, as well as for your areas of interest, skills and competencies.



Your internship will provide you opportunities to contribute to:

- Identifying **priority (research & policy) questions** and relevant conceptual frameworks for addressing them
- Reviewing the scientific and grey literature on relevant policy & societal issues, challenges & solutions
- **Collecting and analysing** data and information from different sources, including via (semi-structured/structured) **interviews** with researchers and stakeholders associated to projects or beyond
- **Presenting results** of your work via notes, reports and briefs as well as during oral presentations in meetings and workshops
- Supporting the **organization and facilitation of (interactive) workshops and trainings** for different target groups in particular stakeholders, decision makers and students
- Supporting **project's coordination and management**, including the organization of partners' meetings and contributions to communication activities and project's deliverables

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- **B.Sc. or M.Sc. student** in marine ecosystem management, political science or social/economic science with an environmental/ocean perspective
- **Skills and competencies,** or **appetite** to discover and apply skills and competencies, relevant to the projects and **activities carried out at ACTeon,** from developing and applying (analytical) frameworks to supporting the organization of workshops and trainings for different target audiences
- Proactive with intellectual curiosity, able to work autonomously with a strong team & collective spirit
- Committed to ecological and climate transitions in general, and to ocean health in particular
- Excellent English (written and oral) communication skills. Proficiency in French is an advantage.

You need to be currently **enrolled** in a University, engineering, institute or vocational school degree with the possibility to do a **practical internship** (e.g. *stage de césure* in French) or **research/thesis internship** as part of your studies.

WHICH ADMINISTRATIVE & WORKING ARRANGEMENTS?

The internship takes place at ACTeon's Colmar office (France – 30 minutes by public transport from Strasbourg or Basel), with home working being a regular practice. Travel (to attend meetings, carry out interviews or contribute to workshops/events) can be expected. The intern will receive a regular internship monthly allowance as defined by French law. The internship duration and starting date is negotiable: **minimum 5-6 month period** or two consecutive internship periods of 5-6 months each (e.g. practical then research internship), **starting (ideally) during the last semester of 2024.**
